

# Cookie policy

## INFORMATION ABOUT OUR USE OF COOKIES

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site.

By continuing to browse the site, you are agreeing to our use of cookies.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

We use the following cookies:

- **Strictly necessary cookies.** These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our website, use a shopping cart or make use of e-billing services.
- **Functionality cookies.** These are used to recognise you when you return to our website. This enables us to personalise our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).

You can find more information about the individual cookies we use and the purposes for which we use them in the table below:

Cookie	Name	Purpose	More information
Session Identifier	ASP.NET_SessionId	This cookie is essential for our site to in order to maintain your session and save your data when you move from one form to another	Any personally identifiable information within this cookie has been encrypted
Egov Log	egovLg	This cookie is essential for our site to in order to preserve the identity of the user. It enables us to:  (a) remain logged into the eGov when navigating to other sections  (b) Recognise and keep you logged in when you return to our site	
Anti cross site attack	__AntiXsrfToken	This cookie is used to help prevent against Cross-site request forgery attacks	

You may block cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of our site.

Except for essential cookies, all cookies will expire after 30 minutes of no activity
